On Wednesday, 8/14/24, The Rotary Club of Montebello was introduced to the FOUR student ambassadors sponsored by Montebello-Ashiya Sister City Association for 2024.

Ashiya, Japan is the City's first sister city partnership. The Montebello-Ashiya Sister City Agreement is part of the "people-to-people program" that was initiated in 1956 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower.

This year, like just about most every year preceding it, going all the way back to 1964, this non-profit program has helped support the exchange of TWO high-school students with both respective communities.

Our local Montebello area High School Students **Isaac Flores**, and **Ben Richards** visited Ashiya earlier this summer and were hosted by local families while there earlier this Summer. We were also introduced to the Ashiya High School students, **Nao Hashimoto** and **Tomohiro Shibabuki**.

Each student spoke to the club, and shared some of their observations of the different societies which they enjoyed and appreciated.

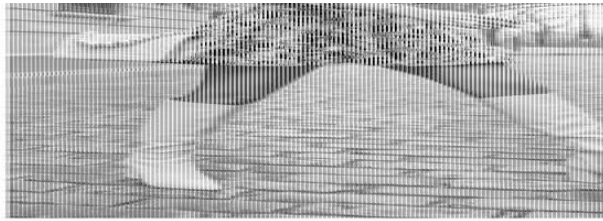
