Ashiya, Japan is the Cityâ€[™]s first sister city partnership. The Montebello-Ashiya Sister City Agreement is part of the "people-to-people program" that was initiated in 1956 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower.

2026 will be the 65th anniversary of the signing of the sister city agreement between the two communities and a delegation from Montebello will be hosted in Ashiya, Japan.


In other Club news and notices:
