The Prescription Shop's Dr. Jaemelene Rodrgio, Pharm D
Dr. Jaemelene Rodrgio, Pharm D alerted the Rotary of the recent uptick in Monkeypox. It is a rare disease caused by infection with the monkeypox virus.

- The Monkeypox virus is part of the same family of viruses as variola virus, the virus that causes smallpox.
- Monkeypox symptoms are similar to smallpox symptoms, but milder;
- Monkeypox is rarely fatal;
- Monkeypox is not related to chickenpox.

Monkeypox spreads in different ways. The virus can spread from person-to-person through:

- Direct contact with the infectious rash, scabs, or body fluids;
- Respiratory secretions during prolonged, face-to-face contact, or during intimate physical contact, such as kissing, cuddling, or sex;
- Touching items (such as clothing or linens) that previously touched the infectious rash or body fluids.

Be proactive in the prevention of Monkeypox.

- Stay out of contact with anyone known to have Monkeypox;
- Always wash your hands.
- Use alcohol-based sanitizer.
- Practice safe sex.
- Stay up to date with your vaccinations.



Dr. Rodrgio updated the Rotary on the Suicide Lifeline. [988 has been designated as the new three-digit dialing code that will route callers to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.](#) When people call, text, or chat 988, they will be connected to trained counselors that are part of the existing Lifeline network. These trained counselors will listen, understand how their problems are affecting them, provide support, and connect them to resources if necessary.
