Prior to joining the Census, Ms. Chen worked in marketing for East West Bank and Fulgent Genetics. She holds an undergraduate degree in Political Science from UCLA, and lived abroad for several years working in international relations and public health. After earning a master's degree in public health and a certificate in humanitarian assistance from the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, she worked in Washington D.C. in various federal agencies, including the Department of State, Department of Health and Human Services, and the Food and Drug Administration. Upon returning to southern California in 2016, she worked for the City of Pasadena and has been active in increasing civic engagement in her community. She serves on the board of the UCLA Rose Bowl Bruins Alumni network, and was a former board member of the UCLA Washington DC Alumni network, Asian American Foreign Affairs Association, and Taiwanese American Professionals DC
