John Valentine-Had the 49th family reunion at Allisot Ranch. Four generations got together and had a great time.

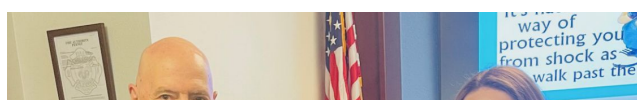
Terri Vernon-Thanked Dan Gray who cleaned up a virus in her computer.

Child Author and Publisher

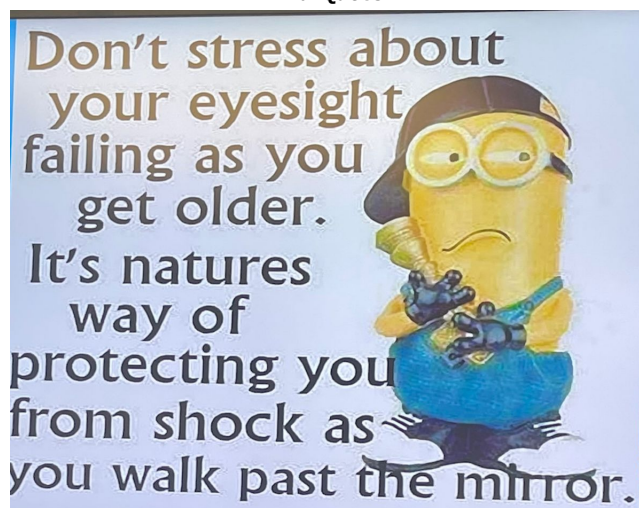
Charity is a local who attended Villa Park School and graduated from Villa Park High School in 2008. At age 7, she was diagnosed with Charcot-Marie-Tooth Disease, a group of hereditary disorders that damage the nerves in the arms and legs, and became wheelchair bound in high school. She currently lives with her parents in Villa Park and has two sisters and one brother. She attended Santiago Canyon College and later graduated from Cal Poly Pomona with a Bachelors degree in Fine arts with a minor in marketing management. She went on to write children's books and start her own publishing company called Purple Diamond Press. Her first book sold over 20,000 copies in the first year. She has won multiple honors for her writing. Her goal is to publish 50 books that are making a difference by 2027.
