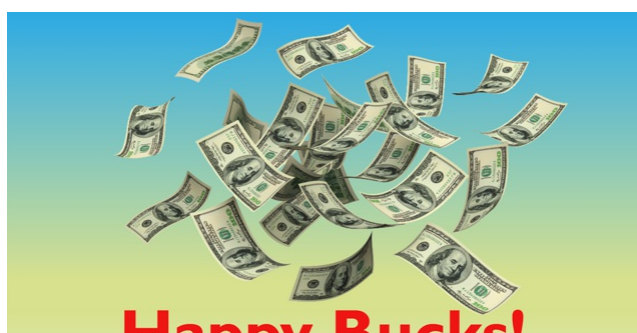

Some of our past grants have been to Kerut, Bracken's Kitchen, The Friendly Center and 3-D printers for the Jewish Day School. The deadline for submission of new grants is June.
