Chrysalis was founded in Los Angeles in 1984 and since then has become an employment resource, providing one on one connections, with their staff. Anyone over 18 is welcome to use their employment services, however, 100% of their clients are low income earners. The non-profit provides their clients with classes that will help provide them the resources they need to find a job, including clothing and practice interviews. Funding comes from private donors and grants. They helped 1553 individuals find employment in a number of industries in 2021. They have locations in Los Angeles, Anaheim, Pacoima, and Santa Monica.
