For people to experience sympathy towards someone else, several elements are necessary:

- You must be paying attention to the other person. Being distracted limits our ability to feel sympathy.
- Listen with the intent to understand.
- The other person must seem in need in some way. Our perceptions of the level of need will determine the level of sympathy.

To feel sympathy for a person or group, you must first pay attention to them. Distractions severely limit the ability to produce strong affective responses. When not distracted, people can attend to and respond to a variety of emotional subjects and experiences.
