Charlie Gallagher - Is happy to have Roy and Janice Jefferson visiting the club today. Its also good

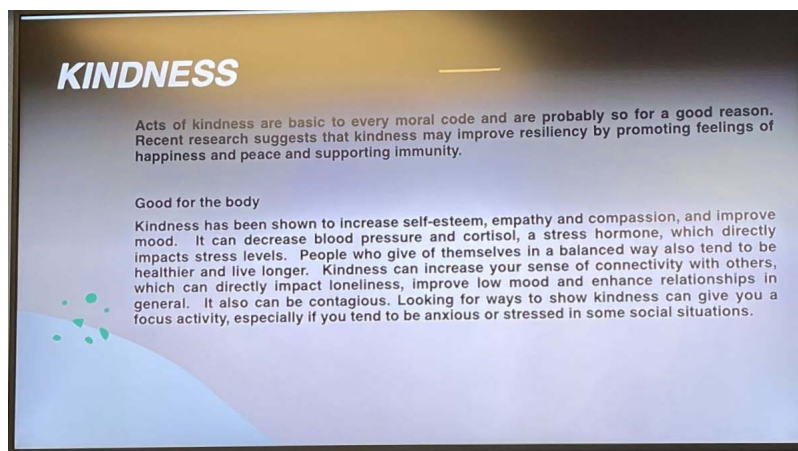

We learned that Roy was one 11 kids in his family and grew up outside Memphis, Tennessee. He is a member of the Anaheim Hills Rotary and has been a State Farm Insurance Agent for 40 years. He is accompanied today by his wife Janice, who has been involved with CASA, an organization to help foster youth. They have 2 children, a boy, Christopher, who is a helicopter pilot for the OC Fire Authority and a daughter, Joana, who recently opened her own dental office in Irvine. He feels that Rotary gives an individual a chance to leave your mark in your community and the world. It's important to let the community know what you're doing. So, after speaking with Supervisor Don Wagner, September will be Service Club Month in Orange County every year. Upcoming activities for the District include: Our annual chili dook-off on October 14th at the Santa Ana Zoo, A non-gala in November, where you can send donations to the Rotary Foundation and a Rotary Walk to support mental illness in April.
