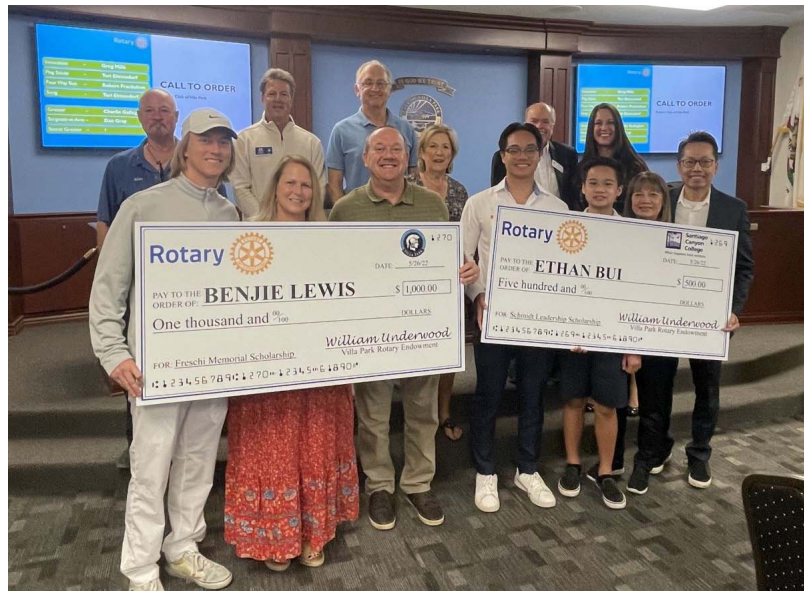

Speaker: US Representative Young Kim She is running for newly created District 40

Representative Kim is the first Korean US Representative. She was born in South Korea and grew up in Guam before moving to Southern California. She attended USC and obtained a business degree with an emphasis on accounting. After leaving college she worked as a controller in mergers and acquisitions firm. She went on to create her own business around 1990. At that time she was introduced to Ed Royce who encouraged her to serve and run for public office. She went on to serve in the State Assembly. She is currently in her freshman term in the US Congress. She sits on 3 committees: Space, Science & Technology and feels strongly that our students need to excel in the STEM subjects; The Small Business Committee-where she encouraged distribution of funds to struggling businesses during and after Covid; and The Foreign Affairs Committee. She takes great pride in her bipartisanship and the fact that she has authored 15 bills and had 4 signed into law. She encourages support of Ukraine, US energy independence, suspending California's Gas Tax, and fighting inflation. She raised four children and is a grandmother.
