- Our club will be participating in a health related project in Guatemala. Mike will arrange for Kevin Padilla to give a presentation to our club in July.

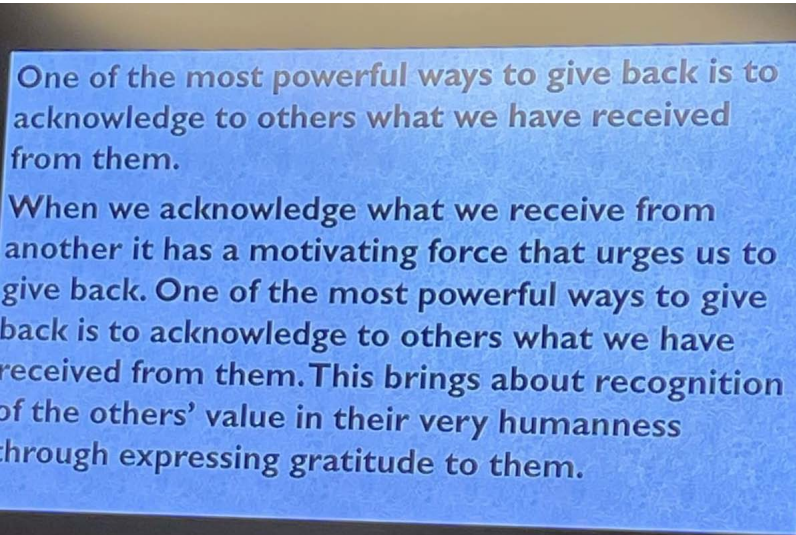
School Update:
