Speaker: John Gyllenhammer Orange City Councilman

John, who has a background in finance, is currently serving his 2nd year on the Orange Council. He presented a frank discussion about the issues facing the city, including pensions, homelessness, maintaining popular city programs/services and how to keep expenses under control. During his time on the Council, they managed to reduce the budget deficit from \$19 million down to \$6 million, but they still have work to do. He answered a number of questions relating to some of the issues above. On the question of contracting services with regard to Orange's 3 public libraries, he prefers that the city own and run the libraries on a reduced budget, as has been done successfully in the surrounding cities of Irvine and Huntington Beach. Very thoughtful presentation.
