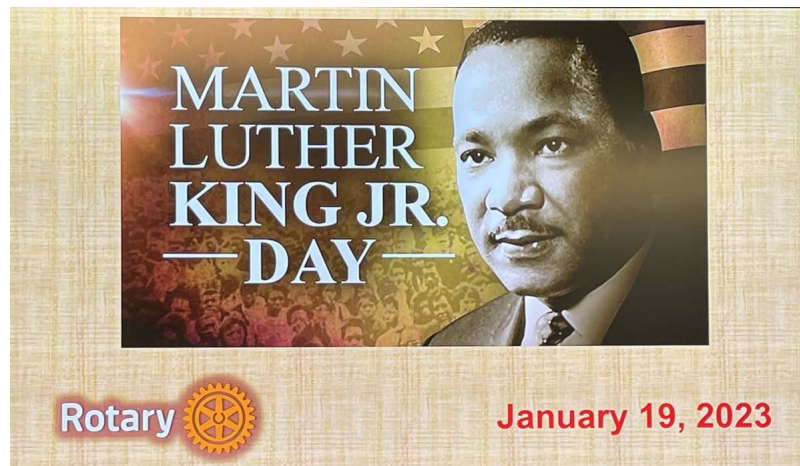

Judge Silberman has decades of experience with worker's compensation law. In 2005 he was appointed a judge by then governor Arnold Schwarzenegger and served in that capacity for 7 years. He is the author of several books in that area that include: Silberman on Vocational Rehabilitation, 132A on Discrimination, Worker's Comp Almanac and the ADR Handbook. He has also lectured on the topic in many major universities. He presented several cases where the claimant made fraudulent claims, received jail time and had to pay restitution.
