**Tree of Life Medical Missions**

This is an organization that provides surgical procedures for the indigenous population in Chiapas, Mexico over the last 12 years. To date, they have provided 12,000 consultations, 6000 life-changing surgeries and 6000 dental procedures, but there is still great need. Each trip costs about \$150,000 and only allows them to do one trip per year. They are in need of donations so they can purchase equipment. They remain committed to providing free medical care, supplies, and medications to those who cannot afford them. They have also begun to sponsor scholarships to economically disadvantaged students in the region.
