**Dr. Beth Manke** received her M.S. and Ph.D. from Penn State University and has twenty years of experience leading student success programs at California State University, Long Beach. As a faculty member in Human Development, she teaches research methods, statistics, and the department's internship course in which she has worked with over 2,500 student interns to chart their post-graduation journeys. As Associate Dean in the College of Liberal Arts, she launched an innovative internship program that successfully centralized and expanded key internship processes including community outreach, assessment/tracking, and the provision of professional development opportunities for students and faculty. Dr. Manke raised funds to create a college-level internship office and hired the College's first ever Career Readiness Advisor and Internship Specialist.

As Associate Vice President for High-Impact Practices, Dr. Manke spearheaded an institution-wide initiative to ensure equitable access to and participation in high-impact practices for all students, including internships and service-learning. These efforts entailed building bridges between Student Affairs and Academic Affairs, creating institutional infrastructures, and giving voice to the most important stakeholders—students. Recently Dr. Manke returned to the faculty to focus on writing her book about internship programming in higher education under contract with Routledge Publishing and to launch/oversee paid internship programs across the campus. She is the Founder and Director of the **Long Beach Community Internship Program** and Co-Principal Investigator of **College Corps @ the Beach**.
