SPEAKER

STEVE DIAZ, MEXICAN CHRISTIAN CHILDREN'S AID/MCCA.

The organization was founded in 1994. Its original purpose was to provide Physical and Spiritual support to orphanages in Mexico. They would take down truck loads of food such as beans, rice, eggs, citrus, tuna across the border once a month, usually the first Saturday.

Times have changed from when they were first established:

1. The Mexican government has started charging tax to bring food across the border, So now they meet at a grocery store across the border and stock up there.
2. Instead of getting donations of goods they now seek donations of money.
3. Children are not in orphanages now but child care centers while their single mothers work at low paying jobs

A typical trip is as follows:

They leave Redlands at 5 a.m. Meet at the grocery store in Tijuana

They have 6 routes with two trucks. They serve about 70 people

They make sure they are home before dark.

They are always seeking volunteers to join them. It isn't necessary to speak Spanish, but if you do it is a great help. It sounds like a very fulfilling experience.
