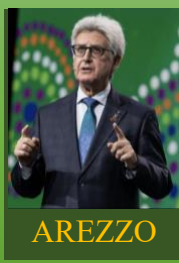
OUR PRAYERS ARE WITH THE LORETTA'S

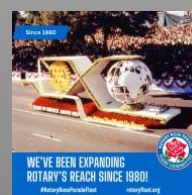
