

Take the completed form & your picture ID (i.e. Drivers License) to a Live Scan facility such as some Notary's & stores like Postal Connection at 42215 Washington St. You will be finger printed. Send an email to Jackie Chatman <u>http://Jackiedhsrotary@gmail.com</u>, letting you know where you have applied. She will let you know when it is approved.
