

A few of the SOS Ride volunteers created 29-PSP to continue providing complimentary transportation (\$200 savings) for active military and their loved ones on leave between the Twentynine Palms Marine base and the Palm Springs & Ontario International Airports. To keep expenses low, 29-PSP is a 100% volunteer organization. All funds raised are used to pay for operational expenses, insurance, fees and providing rides for Marines and their loved ones


