affeliouse of the Desert is a 24-hour emergency sheller whose mission is to serve runsway, homeless, and at-risk youth ages 11 – 17 in the Coachela Valley. Services include three-weeks of emergency shelter, nutritious meals, counseling, attempts at family reunification, on-site education program, aftercare and a 24-hour tol-free crisis line.

While in our programs, youth are provided counseling by a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, Associate Marriage and Family Therapists or Marriage and Family Therapist Interns. Safe-House offers practicum hours and partners with focal universities and online university programs to provide supervision for interns. Supervision at our Youth Programs is provided by Catherhouse.
