Public health workers everywhere already have the answer. Give

them the tools, and developing nations

will apply the lessons learned in this fight against infectious diseases like tuberculosis, malaria,

typhoid fever, and others yet unknown. The end result will be a world that is safer for all of us. Polio Plus Goal for our club = \$2500/year Rotary Foundation Gual for our club = \$10,000/year.

Speaker: President Dennis Sheehan introduced Craig Magaw from SafeHouse.

SafeHouse of the Desert is a 24-hour emergency shelter whose mission is to serve runaway, homeless, and at-risk youth ages 11 - 17 in the Coachella Valley. Services include three-weeks of emergency shelter, nutritious meals, counseling, attempts at family reunification, on-site education program, aftercare and a 24- hour toll-free crisis line.

While in our programs, youth are provided counseling by a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, Associate Marriage and Family Therapists or Marriage and Family Therapist Interns. SafeHouse offers practicum hours and partners with local universities and online university programs to provide supervision for interns. Supervision at our Youth Programs is provided by Catherine Behnke, LMFT #45089

- Provide immediate counseling and intervention services for variable and multiple needs (inner conflict resolution, child abuse / neglect, substance abuse, etc.)
- Reunite the youth with their family (family preservation and reunification)
- Foster self-reliance and responsibility.
- Create an intervention point for runaway and homeless youth before they become juvenile offenders.

Harrison House Transitional Living Program Harrison House TLP offers a unique program consisting of Transitional Living for homeless young adults between the ages of 18-21 years of age and Permanent Supportive Housing for youth ages 18-24 with a Housing Choice Voucher (or other county issued voucher). Participants are aided in developing the life skills needed to live

independent lives.

While in our program, youth are offered counseling by a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, Ann Miller, LMFT #21675
