### **Laundry Love Startup in Palm Springs**

Wednesday, January 24, 2024



Mike Mullins, a former Rotarian, now from the Bermuda Dunes spoke to the club about the Laundry Love program. Laundry Love was formed to help individuals and households wash and dry their clothing and bedding at no cost to them. The machines, detergent and dryer sheets are provided at no charge. This targets helping the homeless but could extend to others in need. Mike told us about the CV Collaborative of charities and how they work together to assist the homeless in our communities. Mike recognized that there was no place for the homeless to access laundry services and raised this to the group which was supportive of the effort. The first "wash†event will be

on February 21st at the Wash Time Coin Laundry on Sunrise Way from 6-10pm. Thereafter, the event will be on the third Wednesday of each month. The location of the events may move around the valley each month. As the events continue, additional services may be available through other charitable partners. The funding is provided through donations collected by Mike.
