Plan-It Life, Inc. â€" Saving Youth At Risk

Nyron McLean, our District Governor Nominee, spoke about his work with Plan-it Life, Inc.

Plan-It Life, Inc. is a non-profit 501(c)(3) residential treatment center for at-



risk youth, ages 12-18. Plan-It Life, Inc. was founded in 2001 by CEO/Administrator Shelia C. Marshall-McLean, LMFT, a Clinical Psychotherapist with a passion for fostering growth and self-awareness in youth. Mrs. McLean envisioned a safe-haven where abused and/or neglected teens could come to learn social skills, decision-making skills, improve their education, receive anger management and therapy, as well as assistance in transitioning into the next phase of their lives.

Nyron and his wife Sheila work with these troubled youth to pull them from troubled situations to improve their lives and futures. Nyron shared stories of kids abandoned, trafficked and/or

abused and how their organization works to provide a foundation to establish a stable and successful life ahead. The organization operates four residential homes in Riverside County.

Nyron shared so many stories of kids who completely turned their lives around to now live meaningful, complete lives.
