Our featured speaker was Cindy Cliburn, Director of Program Services, who has been with Angel View for over 20 years. Angel View was founded in 1954 and boasts 450 dedicated employees, serving clients including children up to seniors that are physically and intellectually challenged. Angel View owns 16 homes, each serving from 4 to 8 clients plus a supervisor. Some homes include 8 hours of nursing assistance. In addition to this, their Outreach Program supports 700 kids living at home.

Angel View depends upon private and corporate donations. They also have 14 retail stores supported by 110,000 donors of items from A to Z!



In the past years, Palm Springs Rotary has sponsored 14 Proms for Angel View clients. This very special program offers lively disco music for the clients who love dancing with our Intectors from PSHS along with some jiving Rotarians! All clients receive a corsage or boutonniere, and have their picture taken before the dancing and dining begins. Festivities begin on Saturday, April 13th, with the
