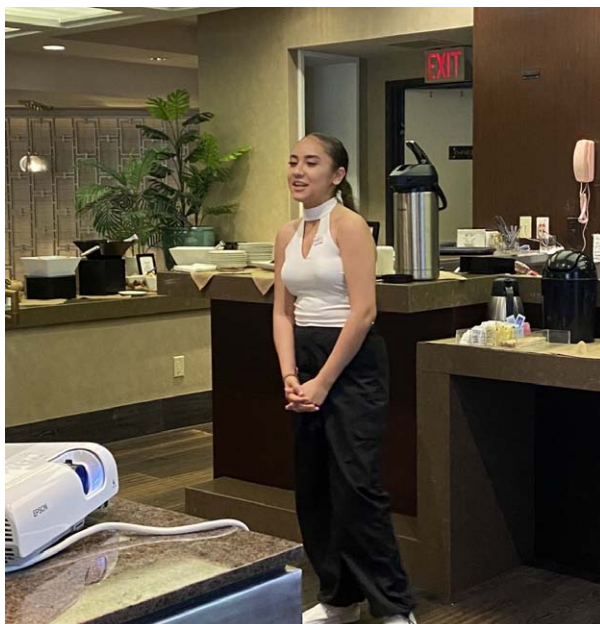

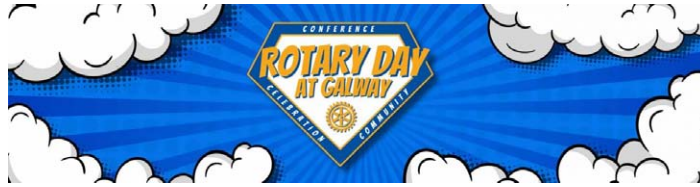
Kerry's passions and goals in service to others are working with vulnerable populations and wants to join Rotary to help her community.
