At Thursday's meeting Chris Willison of the Riverside County Sheriff's Office (RSO) shared an overview of their massive operations. Riverside County is the 4th largest county in the state and 10th largest in the country with more than 2.4 million residents spread across 7,300 square miles. The Department's core values are Integrity, Loyalty, Professionalism and Leadership. The city of Rancho Mirage contracts with the RSO which provides a team of 27 members to protect the city's 19,000+ residents—this number grows to almost 35,000 during a normal "season".
