You probably know a family that would be interested in hosting Martina. It's a very rewarding experience and has been life-changing for some.

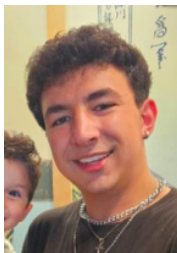
It's a three-month commitment: mid-August through Thanksgiving, OR Thanksgiving through February, OR March through the end of school.

Families do receive a small stipend of \$100 per month and are responsible for getting her to and from a local high school, and to sign them out on occasion for club visits, RYLA, etc.

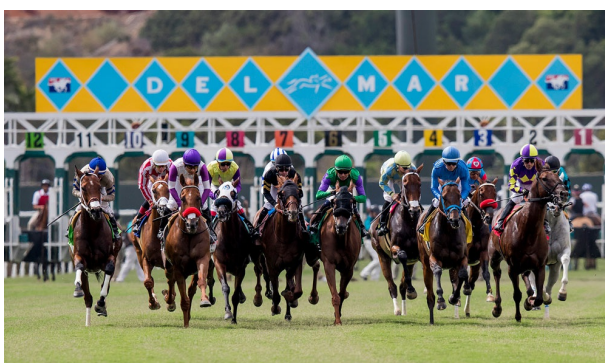
