What a great and informative meeting we had last week with our speaker, Club Foundation Chair Sam Payne. Once again, he reminded us that we Rotarians are all members of Rotary International and we have a global reach, through Rotary' Global Grants. Global Grants focus on projects involving Water, Sanitation and Hygiene, Disease Prevention and Treatment, Maternal and Child Health, Basic Education and Literacy, the Environment, Economic and Community Development and Peace and Conflict Prevention, all of which work to save and better lives daily. As Rotarians we can help by donating to the Rotary Foundation. There are a few goals I believe we, as individuals and as a Club, can achieve.

First, as individuals, is becoming a Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member, by giving \$100 or more per year to the Annual Fund.

Second, if we, as a club, could achieve an average of \$100 per capita in giving and 100 percent participation, with every dues-paying member contributing at least \$25.00 to any or all of the following during the Rotary year: Annual Fund, PolioPlus Fund, approved global grants, or Endowment Fund, our club would become a 100% Foundation Giving Club for the year.

Third, if we as a club, could achieve a minimum Annual Fund contribution of \$100 per Capita during the Rotary Year, and every dues-paying member personally contributing at least \$25 to the Annual Fund during the year, our club would become an Every Rotarian, Every Year Club for the year.

Finally, fourth, if our club contributed as outlined above, each individual member would get closer to earning their next Paul Harris Fellow recognition. Again, Sam reminded us, that the first 9 levels, Paul Harris Fellow to Paul Harris Fellow +8, can be achieved by your direct contribution of money to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus or/and approved Foundation Grant, by members contributing their points in your name, or a combination of both. You can check your status by signing in to your www.rotary.org account. If you have any questions, please reach out to Sam Payne.

And speaking of Paul Harris Fellows, recently our club had the distinct honor of recognizing two of our members, Vickie Walker, who received her Paul Harris Fellow plus 8, and Forrest Baker, who received his Paul Harris Fellow plus 3. Honestly, I think, with just a little more effort, I believe we can reach the goals set forth above. As $Ia \in \mathbb{R}^m$ ve said before, when we became members of Rotary International, we bought the ticket, now let $a \in \mathbb{R}^m$ take the ride and contribute, myself included!

Now, on another note, we have our first major Service Project of the year, this Saturday, September 21st, from 9 am to noon. We will be working with the City of Temecula on a Community Creek & Trail Clean Up. We will meet at the corner of Diaz Road and Via Dos Picos. Remember to wear your yellow Rotary Volunteer Shirts, if you have one. If you don't have one, but have another Rotary shirt, please wear that. I can't wait to get out there and make a difference.

In addition, we do have two Trunk or Treat events, one for the MEU through our Military Committee and one, which will take place at SAFE on October 22nd, through our BRIDGE Committee, and we're asking all our members to donate some bags of candy for these events. You can bring the candy to our club meetings.

Our speaker this week will be our club's Past President Kim Gerrish's husband, Brian Gerrish, who will be talking to us about his life in the Merchant Marines. I'm looking forward to hearing about all of his experiences and I hope to see you all there!




