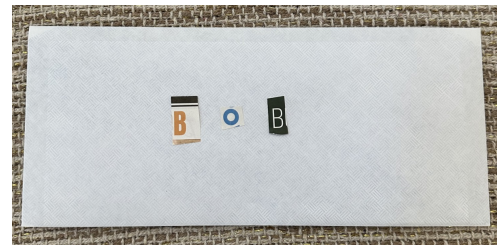

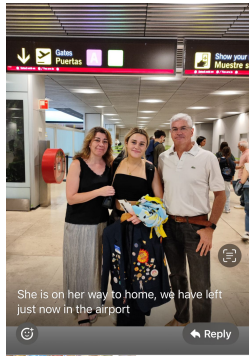
Senior - They put together a wonderful Father's Day Party at Mary Philip's Senior Center, replete with a mounted police presentation, gifts and root beer floats.
