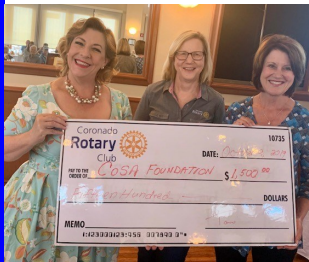
Notes from the Scribe

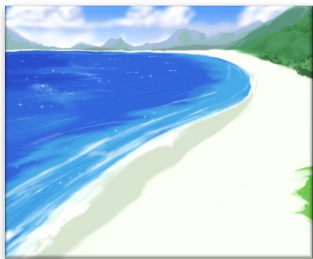
NOTE: Next week we're meeting for the first time ever at the new Feast and Fareway Restaurant at the Coronado Municipal Golf Course!
