Another successful Golf Tourney is in the books thanks to these folks and many more!

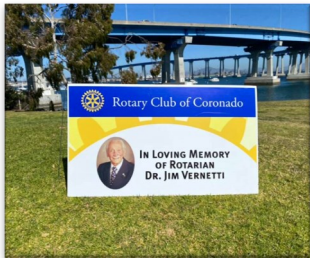
