Jeanmarie Bond was moderator for today's candidate forum featuring our city council hopefuls including Rotarians **Marvin Heinze** (MH) and **John Duncan** (JD) and Carrie Downey (CD) and Piliialoha Estall (PE). They answered four question of interest to us and one from Wayne Strickland.

Q1: Introduction and background?

CD: Experience as past council member, attorney, Navy vet understands the Navy, and zoning issues.

JD: Strong community leader, served on many civic commissions and boards, attorney, created and managed a large law firm.

PE: 4th generation Coronadan, local volunteer

MH: Incumbent, Navy EOD vet, continue record of upgrading infrastructure,

Q2: Three challenges?

JD: TJ sewage, relinquishment, local control stripped away

CD: Relinquishment, sewage, City website upgrade

MH: Underground infrastructure, relinquishment, local control

PE: Local control, housing mandates, sewage

Q3: If elected environmental priorities?

PE: Her background is in environmental policy.

MH: Rotary CPE Chair! Passed Climate Action Plan, solar on public buildings

CD: Recycled water for golf course, up on permitting issues

JD: Different approach focused on what can be done, trash pickup, sewage mitigation

Q4: Two accomplishments on council?

JD: TJ sewage mitigation, better community outreach

CD: City agenda needs to be more available

MH: Relinquishment, local control

PE: local control

Q5: Second Ambulance in the Cays?

MH: Upgrade fire station in the Cays

CD: Endorsed by Firefighters

JD: Endorsed by firefighters AND policemen
