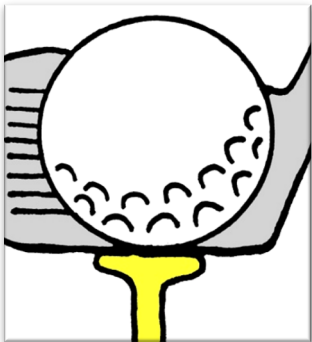
**Congrats to our Peacemaker Award recipients-our fantastic Limbs of Freedom Team, with Rotarians from both sides of the border!**
