### *Notes from the Scribe*

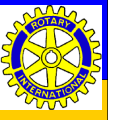

**Kate Carinder** introduced Janelle Nettles who brought us up to date on Camp Able, an entity we (Rotary) used to support. Janelle showed a quick video on the services they provide down at Silver Strand State Beach. While they'd like to provide year around services, currently they serve 600-800 mentally and physically challenged people, over six weeks from toddlers to 83 years old. They operate under SDSU and a special "shout out" to Gene Lamke who was director of Camp Able when **Your Humble Scribe** was Rotary president. **Helen Kupka and Carrie Seigenthaler** rose to tell of the benefits of camps such as Camp Able.
