Jill Olen introduced Sjohnna Knack of the Airport Authority who told us of the changes coming to San Diego International especially Terminal 1. At 24.1 million travelers last year they're almost back to pre-covid numbers. The limiting factor is the one runway, but they're still projecting 39 million passengers by 2035. Terminal 1 will separate the ingress and egress, there will be an outdoor pavilion for eating, drinking, and viewing, and a passel of local restaurants. The good news: There's going to be a new terminal, the bad news: It won't be completed until 2028. We should live so long!
