Program:

We had our annual panel discussion on the financial outlook for the coming year. **Dan Gensler** was the ringmaster and the panelists this year were **Chris Schierhorn, Rainier Trinidad, and Brandon Mather.** We would say they are all bullish to some extent. They were asked about challenges, opportunities, interest rates, bitcoin, tariffs, and their predictions. The challenge is inflation, the opportunity is in tech and health care, interest rates should be lower which is good for equities, crypto is too volatile for most, tariffs are a "jump ball" as it depends on the new president. Now their predictions: Chris sees the market rising 5% over the next year, Rainier sees 7%, and Brandon was most optimistic at 13% growth. We'll check in at the Christmas Party 2025!
