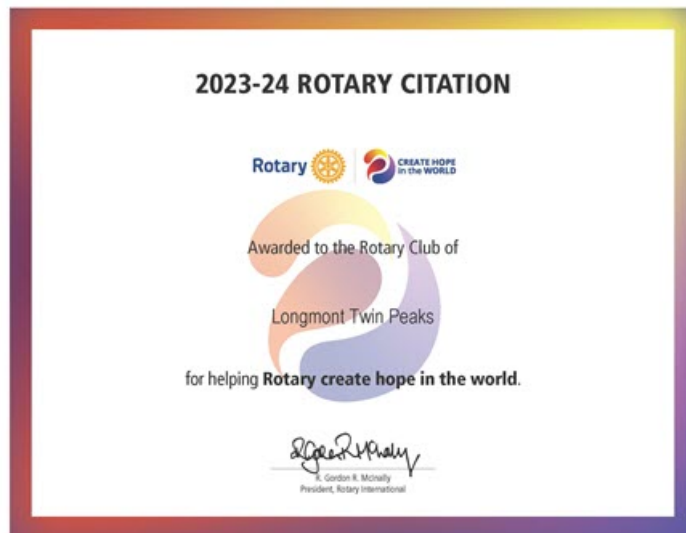
Dear 2023-24 Club President,
