## Update: Rotary and Microaggressions

### Microaggressions? What's that?

**Oxford Dictionary Definition:** Microaggressions are brief, everyday, derogatory slights or insults that communicate hostility and bias (e.g., racism, sexism, heterosexism, homophobia, etc.).

### From Rotary International:

"Rotary has no tolerance for racism, sexism, homophobia, transphobia, classism, or ageism. Agreeing to this with your fellow club members and working together to become more aware of biases and microaggressions will help you create an environment where everyone feels welcome and safe.

This may include telling someone, in a supportive way, when they make a mistake, or pointing out discrepancies between someone's behavior and the club's shared values. At times, you may have to tell someone more firmly that their behavior isn't acceptable. But aim for improvement, not condemnation.

Mistakes can happen even when we're working to improve. Reminding one another what's hurtful and what's better helps the whole community."
