2023-2024 District Governor Jim Johnston

James J. Johnston ("Jim") joined the Rotary Club of Denver in 2008 at the urging of his mother, Peg Johnston, who has been an enthusiastic member since 1993 and a longtime leader of District 5450's PolioPlus efforts. Jim served as Club President from 2019-2020, Service Team VP from 2016-2018, Club TRF Chair from 2009-2010, and currently is chair of the club's strategic planning efforts, "Quest 31". Jim is a Major Donor with The Rotary Foundation.

Today, Jim works with small entrepreneurs as an impact investor and supports his wife's residential remodeling occupation.
