Mark Bodnarczuk will be the Chair of the Twin Peaks Fentanyl Awareness Committee. Mark has a great vision for this educational service with his heartbreaking, personal interest, and is highly motivated to make this an active and effective group.

This includes a strong local presence by working with our local RYLA, YRYLA, local schools and other organizations. Members of this committee will be able to participate at the national or local levels or both. This has the potential to become one of the largest areas of service in our club. This work targets these Rotary's areas of focus: education and child health; areas which our club has strongly supported in the past.

Vision -

The Fentanyl Awareness Committee will:

- a) create a nation-wide presence on the web about Twin Peaks Club's work on Raising Fentanyl Awareness, including in the month leading up to National Fentanyl Awareness Day on May 9th.
- b) facilitate the connection between organizations like Song For Charlie (SFC) and national education organizations of superintendents, principals, teachers, and parents
- c) work directly with kids (ages 13-24) by making presentations at RYLA/YRLA in Rotary District 5450 (and RYLA/YRLA in other Districts) to get the word out directly *to the kids* about the dangers of self-medication in the age of Fentanyl using the SFC materials and others if available.
- d) encourage other Rotary Clubs and Districts to join in the work of raising the awareness about the dangers of self-medication in the age of Fentanyl by making in-person and Zoom presentations to clubs and districts on this issue and the work that Twin Peaks, SFC, and other associated non-profits are doing.
