1. The club will be allowed to use this logo on its fundraiser posters:



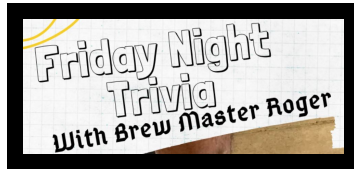
and recognize Smucker's annual \$5000 contribution to Twin Peaks Charity Fund!
