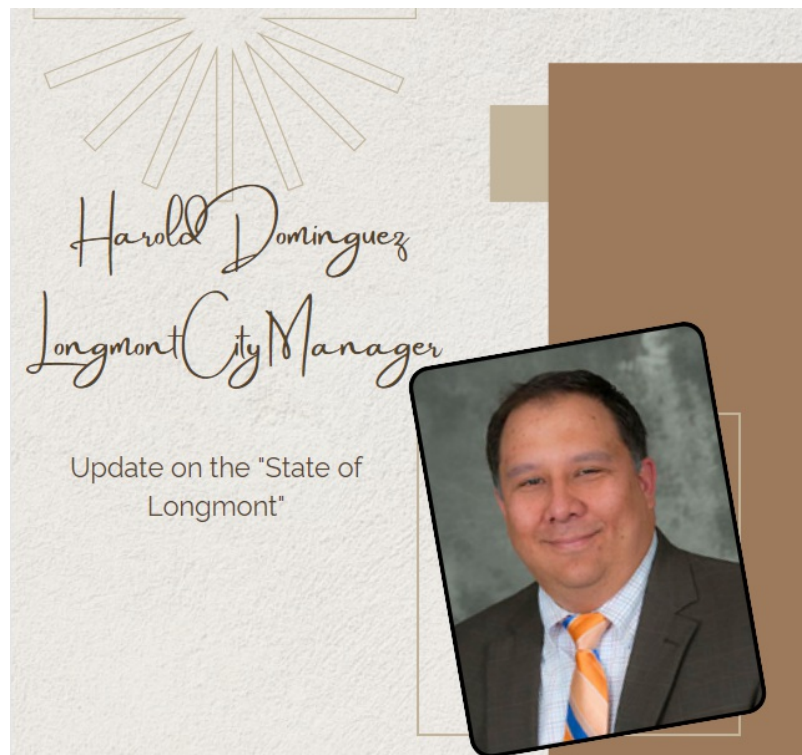

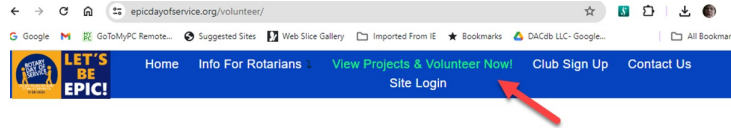

Epic Day of Service on May 18 - Sign Up Has Started!



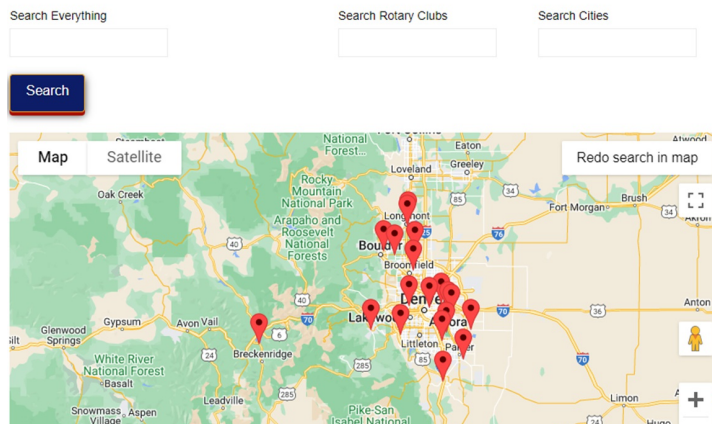

May 18, 2024

Rotarians and community members from across 10 states and 6 countries are coming together on one EPIC Day of Service to make a world of difference in their communities. We invite all Rotary members and friends, family and community members to join this amazing project! Our goal is to unite 25,000 volunteers in 750 communities to take action that will deliver meaningful

Longmont Twin Peaks' project will be our Dickens Farm Nature Center cleanup in the morning. Later in the day Longmont is taking the lead at Growing Gardens. Other nearby projects are being coordinated by Boulder, Boulder Flatirons, Boulder Valley, and Niwot Rotary clubs. Our hope is that Rotarians will feel free to "cross pollinate" and choose to volunteer alongside fellow Rotarians from other clubs.
