Randy has a varied background as golf professional, business person, legislator, and CEO of the Green Valley Chamber. He also serves on a variety of community boards and committees.

Randy has been involved with the Chamber since 2007 and took over his current position three years ago. The Chamber serves its members and the visitor center provides tourist information and serves as a resource for the community and potential future residents. It is a 501(c)6 Business Association promoting and protecting the interests of its members.

He explained how tax increases supporting education, libraries, fire district, etc impacts the business community approximately ten times the impact on an average residential property.

The mission of the chamber is to champion opportunities for business to thrive. It's board of directors has a good mix of business types. There is a

paid staff of four people and many volunteers work in the visitor center.

The Chamber is an advocate to state and federal government, a resource for business support, education, and mentoring, an opportunity to network through introductions and events, and communicating with the community on line, social media, and airwaves. The Chamber serves 402 members including realtors, non-profits, home based businesses, brick and mortar businesses and corporate partners.

The Chamber website includes a membership directory and community calendar. Social media includes Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, and Instagram. On the website can be found the Green Valley Sahuarita Marketplace. Shoppers looking for a particular product can go to that resource, enter the product, and receive a list of local businesses where the product can be found. Businesses can advertise on a job board to assist in hiring and can provide Daily Deal coupons for product discounts. The Chamber's mobile app can be used by Texting GVSBUSINESS TO 866-866-5545. Randy provided a handout with a QR Code for the mobile app.

The Chamber's marketing tools include its website, weekly email newsletter, bi-monthly activity guide, Inside GVS Magazine, GV News & Sun, and KGVY radio. Businesses like to belong to the Chamber for consumer awareness, because Chamber members are viewed favorably, and community members like to support chamber businesses. Other business reasons to belong are to support the Chamber and its mission.

Valle Verde Rotary Club is a member of the Chamber and Randy shared how our club can publicize and market club activities and invite potential new members.
