#### **Rebecca Oravec - Community Share Program**

Rebecca is an art teacher at Wrightson Ridge School and serves as Program Director of the Community Share Program. Much as Rotary began with a group of like-minded friends, the Community Share Program began eight years ago with its founders seeking a way to provide real world learning between community members, teachers, and students.

The program is a non-profit involving ten schools, twenty teachers, and many community members. The program created an online platform for community members to create their own profile enabling teachers and community volunteers to connect sharing information about planned teaching projects and real-world skills and interests of volunteers.

The Sahuarita Educational Enrichment Foundation and the Pima County School Superintendent's Office are partners with Community Share. Freeport McMoran has made a \$10,000 grant and the White Elephant has also been a big help supporting financially.

The online platform is a human library where teachers post a project they plan to teach, students help plan projects, and volunteers express their interest in participating in the project. Community members lend their expertise and time through their careers, their passion, their education, life experiences, and culture.

A community member wishing to participate can create a profile on CommunityShare.org. First select Tucson area, select partner, name, location, organization, experiences, hobbies, life experiences, activities, interests, personal information, contact information, photo, and website information. Any step may be skipped. Teachers looking for a community partner can search the website and find a partner who has the skills and interests which fit the project.

Partners can also scroll through the website to see who else has registered and see what projects are on the site. Contacting teachers/partners can be done on the site and plans made to meet and create a project.
