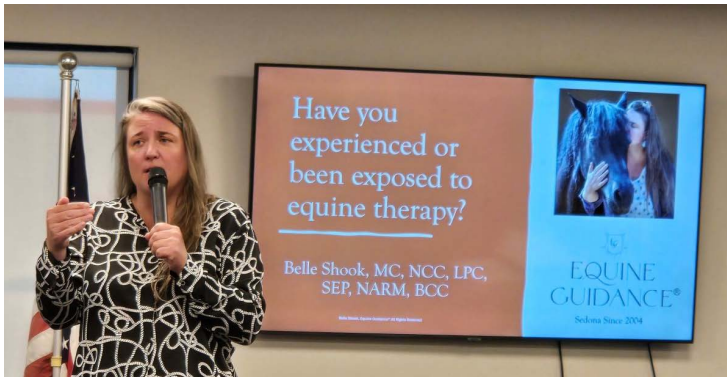

A therapist and pioneer in Equine Therapy, Belle Shook, spoke to DM Rotary on October 17 about her two decades of breakthrough Equine therapy work with her three horses to help clients become aware of & overcome unconscious self-defeating, or stuck behaviors, thoughts, and emotional patterns to heal emotionally and strengthen emotional resilience. This work helps her clients make great strides to move from what was into what can be now, at a neurobiological level.
