Our Guest Speaker: Bill W. Lee with LEF

The Lewisville Noon club was pleased to welcome Bill W. Lee, Executive Director of the Lewisville ISD Education Foundation (LEF), as last week's guest presenter.

Lee started his career in law enforcement with the Harris County Sheriff's Department in Houston before entering the corporate world in media and marketing, which took him to the Studios of Las Colinas. He also served on Governor Bush's board to bring feature film production to Dallas. After Lee briefly retired, he ended up becoming a business development specialist and speaker for the school district, and then director of marketing for Lewisville ISD before stepping into his current position with LEF.



LEF serves as a vehicle to secure private funding benefiting LISD teachers and students. Since its inception in 1990, the nonprofit has given back more than \$7 million in scholarships to students and teacher grants, staff fellowships, and recognition awards. The organization also provides funds for events like the district's Back to School Fair.

LEF is a place for community, with 20,000 constituents, including donors, volunteers, and advocates, Lee noted. He is also planning to leverage his media background to initiate a video testimonial campaign.
