The other employees help with training and mentoring.

Rebecca is also very interested in revitalization of our community. She started The Crossroads, a 5013C that helps small businesses in the community. Upcoming projects are Lucky Days Shopping Event and Kindness Week; working on keeping the flower pots on the square looking fabulous and bringing more family friendly events to the community.

Another project she has undertaken is revitalizing the building next to Harris Interiors. The building is 7200 square feet and have 13 - 15 businesses, restaurants, coffee shops, retail stores. There will also be an AirBNB on the second floor. It will be a small indoor shopping district: A place where people want to hang out and spend time.

And if that is not enough, she is working on a project to Celebrate our Differenes. They hope to have their first fundraiser this fall with women that have done documentaries on various subjects.
