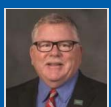

Guest Speakers

Recent Speaker

We were happy to have Cara Gerdiman from Kids Harbor join us this past week to talk about Kids Harbor. It's important that we all have an understanding of the organization that we sponsor. Cara provided a lot of information to the group. In case you missed it, below are some of the topics she covered.

- Kids Harbor has two centers that serves 10 counties and Fort Leonardwood.
- The non-profit organization has two goals: One is to give kids of abuse a safe place to go to receive counseling; the second is a process where law enforcement, child services and medical professionals can handle all aspects of a case in one place. They can do evaluations and medical exams to determine both physical and sexual abuse on site.
- They currently have three full time counselors. They were fortunate to receive a child sex abuse prevention grant this past year which is allowing them to hire a fourth counselor.
- Kids Harbor current provides education to kids at Camdenton and School of the Osage and are talking with both Eldon and Lebanon to add the service to those school districts as well.
- "Stewards of Children" is an adult education program that is available. In they worked with 684 adults on how to recognize, respond and report abuse. This is a great program to bring to churches, clubs and organizations or places of work.
- In 2020, 713 children were referred to Kids Harbor. This number is actually down from previous years. Abuse typically increases during times of economic downturn; however, due to the lockdown, virtual school, canceled activities, kids were not "seen" in schools and activities therefore less of an opportunity for adults to recognize, respond and report possible abuse.
- April is Child Abuse Prevention month. The symbol is a blue pinwheel. You can order pinwheels to place in your yards or place of business or blue t-shirts. They are also promoting "Blue Friday" throughout the month to bring awareness to the cause.
- On April 24 they will be holding "Go Blue Bar-B-Que Bash." This includes several competitions and a raffle for a side of beef.
- Abused kids do not necessarily become abusers as adults, but it does cause other adverse experiences such as impact on mental and physical health, criminal behavior and pervasive attitude towards abuse to other kids.

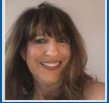
