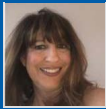

Below is information they have shared with us.



My name is Irelyn Meckley, and I am currently a senior at Camdenton High School. My family and I have lived at the Lake of the Ozarks for the past four years, since my father retired from his 20 year career in the United States Army. While at Camdenton, I have participated in a number of extracurricular activities as well as community service organizations including: National Honor Society, Key Club, Science Research, LASER 3284 Robotics, Girl's Swim Team, A+ Program, and Girl's Track and Field.

Some of my favorite school activities have been my participation in the science research program and the Lady Laker swim team. I have been accepted into the Aerospace Engineering Program at the Georgia Institute of Technology, beginning in the fall of 2021. I would like to get a job as an engineer for a private or federal defense contractor like SpaceX, Boeing, Lockheed Martin, or DARPA to help develop the next generation of aerial technologies.

My name is Eli Griffin and I am a resident of Montreal, Missouri. I grew up in Montreal on a small farm. I have three siblings: an older sister and brother and a younger sister.  - a. Your username is the email address affiliated with your Rotary account.
 - b. If you have not signed in before, your password is your Member ID which can be found on your Rotary Magazine as shown below (Image 2). If you've signed in before and can't remember your password please select **Forgot Password** under the blue login button.

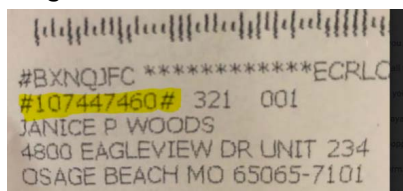
