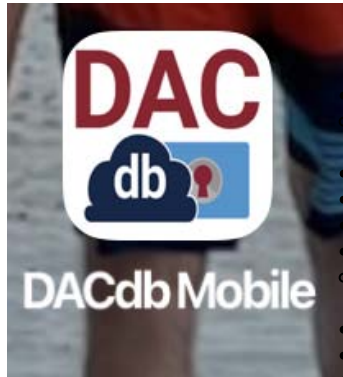

This can be obtained by each club member for a monthly donation of less than \$ 9.00 a month. All you will need to do is log in to Rotary.org.
